Tour any or all of the Salt Spring Island locations on the map below. Learn about rainwater collection, treatment and usage at various scales. See page 2 for details about each stop.

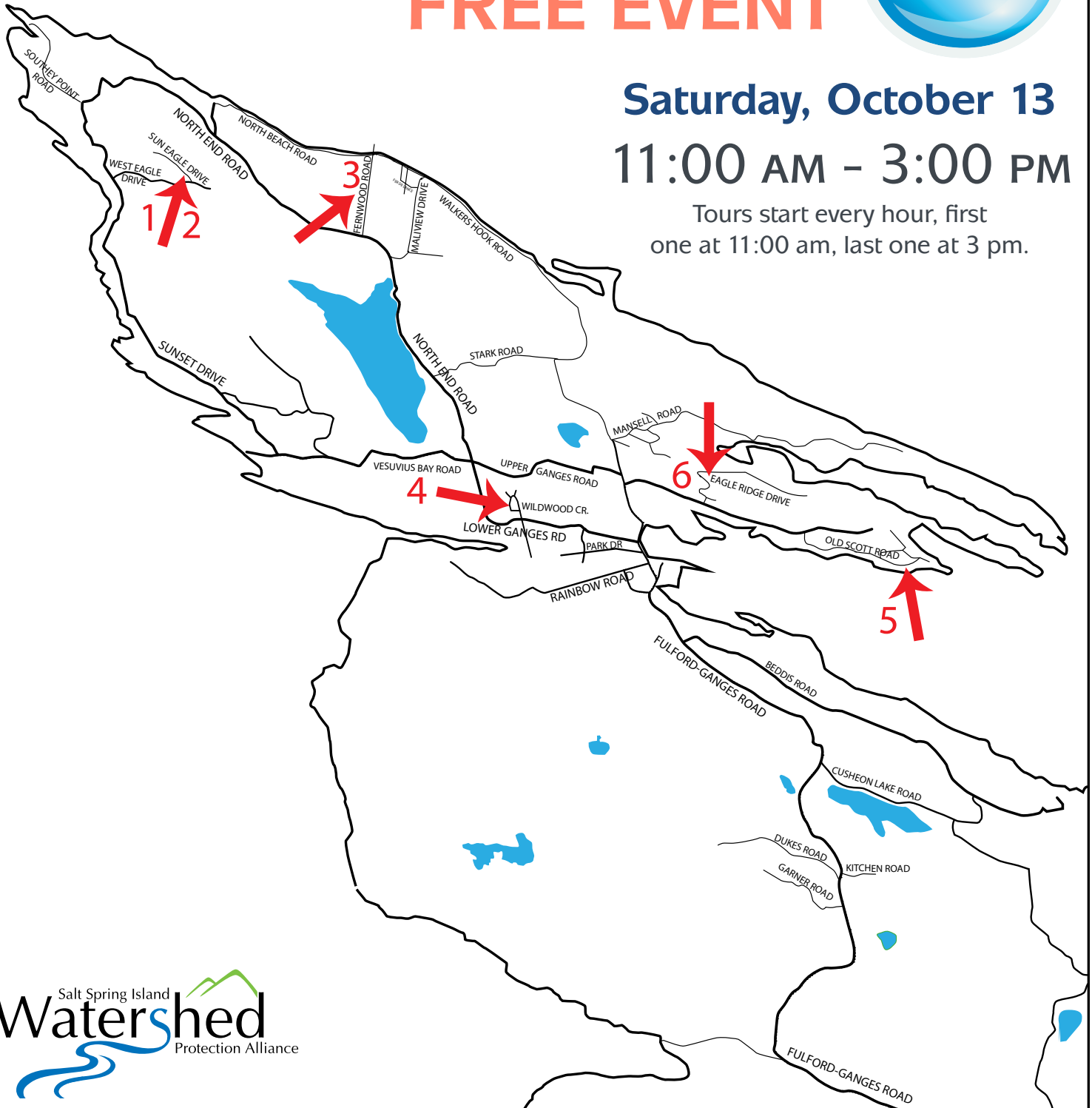
